The Cornwall Public Library Board of Trustees, Orange County, New York, gives notice that a Special District Meeting of the qualified voters of the Cornwall Central School District will be held at the Cornwall Public Library, 395 Hudson Street, Cornwall, NY 12518 on Tuesday, April 17, 2018 from 9:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. for the purpose of voting by voting machine on the Proposition on the Cornwall Public Library operating budget for the July 1, 2018 - June 30, 2019 fiscal year and for the election of one (1) member of the Cornwall public Library Board of Trustees.

LIBRARY TAX LEVY PROPOSITION

Notice is hereby further given that a copy of the statement of the amount of money which will be required for the ensuing year for public library purposes, may be obtained by any School District Resident fourteen (14) days prior to the Special District Meeting, at the Cornwall Public Library, 395 Hudson Street, Cornwall, NY 12518 during regular library hours listed below:

Notice is hereby further given that a special informational meeting of the qualified voters of said School District will be held at the Cornwall Public Library, 395 Hudson Street, Cornwall, New York on April 4 at 6:30 p.m., concerning the Library Tax Levy Proposition to be submitted at said Special District Meeting.

ELECTION OF LIBRARY TRUSTEES

Library Trustees will be elected at the Special District Meeting on April 17, 2018. Notice is hereby further given that petitions to nominate candidates to the office of Trustee of the Cornwall Public Library Board of Trustees are available at the Cornwall Public Library during regular library hours listed above.

Petitions must be filed at the Cornwall Public Library, 395 Hudson Street, Cornwall, NY 12518 no later than 6 p.m. on March 23, 2018. The following position is to be filled: one (1) full term of three (3) years.

Notice is also hereby given that pursuant to Section 2014 of the Education Law, personal registration of voters is required, and no person shall be entitled to vote at said meeting whose name does not appear on the register of said School District or who does not register as hereinafter provided, except a person who is otherwise qualified to vote and is registered under the provisions of Article 5 of the Election Law. The Board of Registration shall prepare a register for said special district meeting, except that the register prepared at the last annual meeting or

election shall be used as the basis therefore and shall include all persons who shall have presented themselves personally for registration thereat and also all persons who shall have been previously registered hereunder for any annual or special district meeting or election and who shall have voted at any annual or special district meeting or election held or conducted at any time within four (4) years prior to the preparation of said register.

Any person shall be entitled to have his or her name placed upon the register by personally registering at the Special District Clerk's office, 395 Hudson Street, Cornwall, NY 12518, at least five (5) days prior to the Special District Meeting, during normal Special District business hours set forth above. The register prepared pursuant to Section 2014 of the Education Law shall be filed in the office of the District Clerk and will be open for inspection by any qualified voter of the District on each of the five days prior to and the day set for the Special District Meeting, between the hours of 9:00 o'clock a.m. and 5:00 o'clock p.m. prevailing Time, except Saturday April 7 and Sunday April 8, 2018.

Notice is hereby given that applications for absentee ballots may be applied for at Cornwall Public Library. Any such application must be received by Cornwall Public Library at least seven (7) days before the date of the aforesaid Special District Meeting if the ballot is to be mailed to the voter, or the day before such Special District Meeting if the ballot is to be delivered personally to the voter. A list of all persons to whom absentee voter ballots shall have been issued shall be available for public inspection in the office of Cornwall Public Library not less than five (5) days prior to the date of the Special District Meeting (excluding Saturdays and Sundays) during regular office hours until the date of the aforesaid Special District Meeting. Absentee ballots must be received by the Special District Clerk no later than 5:00 o'clock p.m. on the day of the vote.
